WISCONSIN DISTRICT MUSIC MINISTRY COVENANT

Realizing the importance, privilege and responsibility of the Wisconsin District Music Ministries, I hereby declare:

That I have repented of my sins, been baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of my sins, and have received the gift of the Holy Ghost with the initial evidence of speaking in other tongues (according to Acts 2:38).

Further, I will endeavor to be faithful in the following areas:

1. I will be at all scheduled practices.
2. Because I am upholding God's reputation, I make a covenant to look my best. I agree that:

Men should be clean shaven – no beards or mustaches. Their hair should be worn above the ears, and off of the collar; it should be their natural coloring. Appropriate attire for participation in WDMM events are slacks, dress shirt, tie, socks and dress shoes. No jeans or tennis shoes are acceptable, and sleeves should come to the elbow.

Ladies should have neat, uncut hair that is their natural coloring. Appropriate attire for participation in WDMM events includes: dresses and skirts with hems that fall below the knee; (if skirts have splits, they should not extend above the bottom of the knee—front, sides and back); modest blouses or tops with necklines that fall above the collarbone—front and back. No clothing should be tight-fitting or of see-through material, and sleeves should cover arms, even when the arms are raised. No jean dresses/jumpers, jean skirts, culottes, tennis shoes are acceptable. Makeup of any kind, necklaces, and/or earrings are also not acceptable. I understand that wedding rings may be worn.

3. I understand that my appointment with the WDMM is based upon my willingness to fulfill this Covenant to the best of my abilities. I realize that if I am to be an effective leader in worship, I must first be an example of what my church and the Wisconsin District stands for and teaches.

I further understand that my character and conduct beyond the instruments or platform is just as important as when I am behind the instruments or microphones.

4. I understand that if I fail to fulfill this Covenant, I will be dismissed from my music ministry responsibilities until the matter is resolved.
5. I make a covenant to be loyal to those that have been placed in authority by the Wisconsin District Board.
