North American Youth Congress

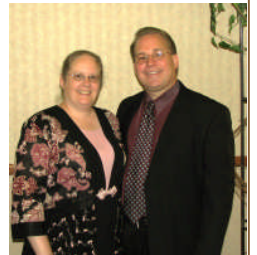
was held in Charlotte, North Carolina. Wisconsin Youth Ministries coordinated several chartered buses filled with Wisconsin youth to the congress.
